This pamphlet provides you with the **full schedule of the Advent and Christmas season**, as well as a suggestion for **family or personal meal prayer**.

We also provide you a copy of "Wonders of His Love: Family Devotions and Activities of Advent", by Amy Welborn. This can be used daily for your personal prayer and reflection. You may also wish to use parts of it, perhaps once a week before Sunday Eucharist, as part of a family prayer or discussion. The Advent themes offered in this booklet speak to our deepest longings: peace, light, hope, mercy and the coming of Christ the Saviour. Let us ponder the real meaning of the Advent-Christmas season as one which reflects the joy of God's interaction with us, even in the midst of this busy season.

#### **Eucharist of the Sundays of Advent**

1 December, 8 December, 15 December, 22 December Vigil Mass: Saturdays – 4:30 p.m. Sundays - 8:30, 10:00, and 11:30 a.m.

#### **Celebration of Reconciliation**

Before all Saturday evening Masses, at 4:00 p.m. Advent Communal Reconciliation: Thursday, 12 Dec., 7:00 p.m.

#### **Eucharist of Christmas**

Christmas Eve, Tuesday 24 December: **4:30 p.m.**, **7:00 p.m.** (with incense), and **10:00 p.m.** (preceded by half hour program of music at 4:00, 6:30, and 9:30 p. m.)

Christmas Day, Wednesday 25 December: **10:00 a.m., 11:30 a.m.** (with incense)

## Feast of the Holy Family

Vigil Mass: Saturday, 28 December: **4:30 p.m**. Sunday, 29 December: 8:30, 10:00 and 11:30 a.m.

# New Year's Eve and New Year's Day (Day of Obligation)

Vigil of Mary, Mother of God: Tuesday, 31 December: 4:30 p.m.

Feast of Mary, Mother of God: Wednesday, 1 January: 10:00 and 11:30 a.m.

#### **Eucharist of the Epiphany**

Vigil Mass: Saturday, 4 January, 4:30 p.m.

Sunday, 5 January: 8:30, 10:00 and 11:30 a.m.

## Eucharist of the Baptism of the Lord

Vigil Mass: Saturday, 11 January, **4:30 p.m.** 

Sunday, 12 January: 8:30, 10:00 and 11:30 a.m.

Prepare the way of the Lord; make His paths straight.


O God, You promise: "My word will not pass away." Help us each day to look to your Word.
