## JOYFUL NEWS - WEEKEND MASSES TO RESUME JULY 4!

Our plan is to resume Weekday Masses on Canada Day, July 1st. Weekend Masses will resume on July 4th. Please note that we will not have daily adoration, we will not have Wednesday devotions and Mass at 4:30pm and we will not have Saturday morning Masses until the situation is normalized. Our Mass times in July will be: Monday-Friday 9am,

Saturday 4:30pm, Sunday 8:30am, 10am, 11:30am.

We encourage everyone to adhere to the Ottawa Public Health guidelines - if you are 65 and older, have a chronic condition or have a compromised immune system you may be at higher risk of developing complications. Please remember that **Sunday obligation is suspended until further notice** so it is not mandatory that you return to Mass at this time. Please stay safe. You might prefer attending a weekday Mass where it is less crowded.

**Things will be different.** You will notice many changes when you return. **We want to keep each other safe.** Here are some of the changes you can expect:

- You will be asked to <u>please stay home</u> if you exhibit any of the symptoms of flu or COVID19 including fever, sore throat, coughing, sneezing.
- You must wear a mask or face covering when you attend and you are asked to please bring your own sanitizer as well, if possible. Other-wise sanitizer will be available at the entrance & exit doors.

You do not need to register for Mass. We do not want to turn anyone away but we are limited to 100 people – please be patient as we move forward. For a more detailed description of what to expect please check the latest Update for Parishioners found on our website.

**Welcome back!** We know these are a lot of changes to process. Don't worry – we will have volunteers to guide you along the way. We have missed you and are looking forward to being able to worship together in person. With your help we can do so safely.

1) **Reflection on the 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time:** Discipleship is connected with hospitality and building a personal



relationship with Christ. This is a choice of paramount importance and life-transforming. Dying and rising with Christ defines who we are and how we live.

- 2) **Reflection on the 14<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time:** The burden and challenges of life at times overwhelm us, but we have the assurance of Christ who lightens our burden if we draw life from him. Our faith informs us that he abides by us, sustains us by his ongoing presence, guiding us to make decisions that are life-giving!
- 3) On June 8<sup>th</sup> the Province announced it is allowing places of worship to open as long as best practices are followed. We are limited to 30% capacity which means 100 people. The Archdiocese followed up with a document on June 11 highlighting what each parish must have in place before opening.

We need many volunteers to exercise their discipleship during this critical time to assist us so that we can secure the safety and security of our parishioners. For this reason, we shall put the proper procedures in place and open slowly as of Canada Day on Wednesday, July 1st. If you can help please contact me at pastor@fatimaparish.ca or 613-722-7661x3.

3) For the month of July we shall not have servers, nor choir/music during Mass. We shall not have the vigil lights (candles) or holy water readily available. **Kneelers will not be used**. Please do not linger in church after Mass, as we need time to sanitize the church. Entrance will be through the main door, and exit will be at the side entrance to the church and by St. Joseph's statue.

Should the situation improve we shall carefully open up gradually to ensure there is no second wave of infection. We will keep the regular weekend Mass schedule in order to ensure not too many will be turned away when Mass resumes.

- 4) We continue to live-stream Masses every day at 9 am. Please connect via the parish website. We can also keep in touch electronically through Parish Bulletin & Weekly emails which you can check out on the parish website. After July 1<sup>st</sup> we hope to continue the livestream Mon-Fri 9am, Sat 4:30pm, Sun 8:30am.
- 5) During the months of July and August the bulletins will be available every two weeks. If necessary, we shall send you an email message to update you on evolving situations.
- 6) I would like to express our gratitude to the following lay leaders who have ended their terms of service or are moving on to serve in other ministries: Myla Haack served as Liturgical Coordinator and Baptism Coordinator. Robert Haack served in the Knights of Columbus and Finance Council. Glenn Provick moves on from serving as Vice-Chair of Pastoral Council and will replace Myla as Liturgical Coordinator. Zenon Slodki ends his 6-year service as Chair of Pastoral Council. Thank you to Myla, Robert, Zenon and Glenn your dedication and commitment have been invaluable and your hearts of service provide a shining example of what it means to live your faith and practice true discipleship. We also congratulate Deacon Michael Closs who celebrates 25 years of service as Deacon. He has been connected with our parish for a number of years!
