1) Lenten Reflection: Today's gospel (John 4.5-42) records the meeting between Jesus and the Samaritan



woman at the well, an event that reminds us immediately of Christian baptism. Part of this gospel reads as follows: "But the hour is coming, and is here now, when the true worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and in truth; for the Father seeks such as these to worship him. God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth." This is the way that we must approach the feast of Christian Passover. We need these forty days of preparation because this feast challenges us to give our lives fully to the glory of God. It challenges us to worship in spirit and truth. This week is a good time for us to reflect on the quality of our participation in the Eucharistic prayer. It is in the Eucharistic prayer that we offer the gift of our lives for the glory of God. If we open ourselves to this prayer more fully from Sunday to Sunday, we will be preparing in the best possible way for the coming feast. (National Bulletin of Liturgy, vol. 33 #165)

She will scrutinize her life and seek to purify her intention to follow Christ and be enlightened by the Gospel way of life. At the general intercessions, we will also have our Lenten Renewal. Please support her journey to discipleship with our prayers.
- 4) To help us deepen our Lenten spirit, Archbishop O'Brien will reflect with us "The Spirit of Lent" after a light lunch at the conclusion of the 11:30am Mass, March 22<sup>nd</sup>. Please take advantage of this opportunity for our Lenten Renewal.
- 5) Please note that our Lenten Reconciliation Service will be celebrated on **Wednesday, April 1**st **at 7:00pm.** Also, individual confession is available through the Lenten Period at 4:00pm every Saturday evening, and before every weekday Mass 8:30-8:45am.
