THANK YOU FOR YOUR CONTINUED SUPPORT! To date we have spent \$2,513.35 on sanitizing equipment/products plus \$1,230.84 for technological equipment so that we may livestream the Mass. We appreciate your continued financial support as we depend solely on your contributions in order to sustain our operations.

PLEASE ARRIVE BEFORE MASS BEGINS: as a courtesy to the Hospitality Ministers. They have difficulty participating in Mass if you arrive late or at the last minute, as they need to bring you to your seat and do sanitizing and contact tracing. During the Liturgy of the Word you will be asked to wait at the entrance until the liturgical action is finished. Thank you for your cooperation. **WILL MASS BE FULL?** We are allowed 30% capacity which in our case puts the limit at 100 people. We are averaging 50 people during weekday Mass (Mon-Fri 9am) and last weekend our weekend attendance figures were as follows: Sat 4:30pm **52**, Sun 8:30am **58**, Sun 10:00am **63**, Sun 11:30am **55**. **All are welcome.**

HOLY LAND SPECIAL COLLECTION: Normally this Collection is taken up on Good Friday. **This year Pope Francis has approved that the Collection for the Holy Land take place this weekend September 12/13.** The collection is reserved to help support the Christian holy places, pilgrimage facilities in the Holy Land and the needs of the poor and vulnerable. If you have not already contributed to this special collection, you may use a blank envelope marked "Holy Land". Thank you.

MASS TIMES: Monday-Friday 9am, Saturday 4:30pm, Sunday 8:30am, 10am, 11:30am and live streamed on Saturday 4:30pm and Sunday 10:00am. We want to keep each other safe. Here are some of the changes you can expect:

- You will be asked to **please stay home** if you exhibit any of the symptoms of flu or COVID19 including fever, sore throat, coughing, sneezing.
- You must wear a mask or face covering when you attend and you are asked to please bring your own sanitizer as well, if possible. Otherwise sanitizer will be available at the entrance & exit doors.

You do not need to register for Mass, however you must provide contact information as per Ottawa Public Health. We do not want to turn anyone away but we are limited to 100 people – please be patient as we move forward. Unfortunately the washroom is only available for emergencies as it needs to be sanitized after each use. We are complying with directives from the Archdiocese and health regulations. **Our volunteer ushers will direct you to your seat. Please follow their instructions and do not move from your assigned spot.** For a more detailed description of what to expect please check the latest Update for Parishioners found on our website.

WHY DO I NEED TO SIGN IN AT MASS? Ottawa Public Health requires all places of worship to maintain an attendance log for purposes of contact tracing in case of an outbreak. **This is for your protection so that they can contact you if necessary.** Please sanitize your hands and look for your LAST NAME on the list, then place a checkmark beside your name. If you cannot find your name please print it on the blank sheet provided, along with your phone number. The usher will then guide you to your seat. Records will be kept private and destroyed after 30 days. Many thanks for your patience and co-operation!

WELCOME BACK! We know these are a lot of changes to process. Don't worry – we will have volunteers to guide you along the way. We have missed you and are looking forward to being able to worship together in person or watch the Mass which will be live streamed at 4:30pm on Saturday and at 10:00am on Sunday whenever possible.

WELCOME BACK CHOIR DIRECTORS! Beginning this weekend Peter will resume playing at the 4:30pm Mass, and Jon will resume at all Sunday morning Masses. Unfortunately we will still be without choirs as it is still not safe to sing in close proximity. 1) Reflection for the 24th Sunday in Ordinary Time:



Forgiveness is an indispensable key to any relationship, as we can inadvertently hurt one another in words and deeds. Our Christian identity is based on our having experienced God's mercy, we extend the same to others by the ability to forgive, as we are earnestly reminded every time we pray the Our Father!

2) We are grateful for the volunteers who exercise their discipleship during this critical time who assist us so that we can secure the safety and security of our parishioners. Please wear a personal mask/face cover to protect yourself and others and have available sanitizers. **We are in need of more volunteers to relieve and divide responsibilities. If you are in a position to help, please connect with me or the parish office. Thank you!**

3) During the pandemic, the provincial regulation and diocesan guidelines are that we should suspend Communion in the tongue until the pandemic is over and it is safe to do so. Please be considerate for the safety of others and be respectful of the policy during this time. This gesture of care for others when we receive the Lord is most appropriate!

4) Beginning this weekend, we will have an organist/cantor to provide us with music during Mass. Please refrain from singing at this particular time for safety reasons. We shall continue to read the Gloria.

5) We shall help you fill your container with holy water, and vigil lights can be lit before and after Masses. Offerings for vigil lights can be placed in the tube near the statue of Our Lady of Fatima. Weekend offerings can be placed in the tubes at the main entrance and by the St. Joseph statue.

6) Please do not linger in Church after Mass as we need the time to sanitize the Church. Entrance will be at the main door and we will exit near the ramp door by St. Joseph statue.

7) We continue to live-stream at the 4:30pm Saturday and 10:00am Mass on Sundays whenever possible. Those who are not ready to return to church for Mass can benefit from it if you have a computer, cell phone or other electronic devices. Please connect via the parish website at www.fatimaparish.ca.

8) We are thankful that weekend worship is possible but things are not yet back to normal. At this time we shall keep the regular confession and Mass schedule (Monday-Friday morning Masses only). Anything beyond will have to wait until we have some normalcy.

9) We have made available printed copies of the bulletin. Please pick up your copy as you leave the church.

10) The province now requires contact-tracing for worshippers in the event someone is found to be a carrier of the virus. Please co-operate with us so that we can respond to this safety measure which is also sanctioned by the Archdiocese.

11) Please make an effort to be punctual for Mass as a courtesy to the hospitality ministers so they can participate at Mass without being constantly interrupted seating you, sanitizing and contact tracing. During the Liturgy of the Word you will have to wait at the entrance until the liturgical action is finished.
