1) Reflection for the 33<sup>rd</sup>
Sunday in Ordinary Time: The
gospel helps us to reflect upon
how we use the talents with which



God endows us. In Proverbs, the enterprising and capable wife does not focus upon herself, but reaches out to care for others, such gestures of kindness draw praises from others who are drawn to her positive qualities! Like her the Gospel calls us to use our God-given talents with generosity instead of hiding them!

- 2) November is the month of remembrance. We begin with the Solemnity of All Saints on November 1 (Sunday), followed by the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls' Day). Prayer in communion with the saints and for the deceased, are part of our practice. The remembrance of the deceased by a Mass intention is a long tradition in our Church. During this month, because of COVID, parishioners can call the office or email us the names of deceased members of their family and friends and we will inscribe them in the memorial book and pray for them at every Mass in November.
- 3) In addition to Remembrance Day on November 11 when we honour those who gave their lives so that we have peace, we shall celebrate two Masses in November (Wednesday, November 18 and 25) for the faithful departed whose names are inscribed in the book of life, especially for those who died of the coronavirus.
- 4) We are grateful for the volunteers who exercise their discipleship during this critical time who assist us so that we can secure the safety and security of our parishioners. Please wear a personal mask/face cover to protect yourself and others and have available sanitizers. We are in need of more volunteers to relieve and divide responsibilities. If you are in a position to help, please connect with me or the parish office. Thank you!
- 5) Please make an effort to be punctual for Mass as a courtesy to the hospitality ministers so they can participate at Mass without being constantly interrupted bringing you to your seat, do sanitizing and contact tracing. Late comers will have to wait inside the main entrance until the liturgical action, sanitizing and contact tracing is finished, before being seated.
- 6) We begin our preparation for Christmas liturgies: the pandemic necessitates registration for attending Christmas Masses in order to ensure the safety of all participants. Please cooperate by signing-in through the website or in person. Unfortunately no last minute admissions will be accepted for those Masses.
