JOYFUL NEWS - MASSES HAVE RESUMED! Our Mass times are: Monday-Friday 9am, Saturday 4:30pm, Sunday 8:30am, 10am, 11:30am.

Things will be different. You will notice many changes when you return. **We want to keep each other safe.** Here are some of the changes you can expect:

- You will be asked to **please stay home** if you exhibit any of the symptoms of flu or COVID19 including fever, sore throat, coughing, sneezing.
- You must wear a mask or face covering when you attend and you are asked to please bring your own sanitizer as well, if possible. Otherwise sanitizer will be available at the entrance & exit doors.

You do not need to register for Mass, however you must provide contact information as per Ottawa Public Health. We do not want to turn anyone away but we are limited to 100 people – please be patient as we move forward. We are complying with directives from the Archdiocese and health regulations. Unfortunately the washroom is only available for emergencies as it needs to be sanitized after each use. **Our volunteer ushers will direct you to your seat. Please follow their instructions and do not move from your assigned spot.** For a more detailed description of what to expect please check the latest Update for Parishioners found on our website.

ATTENDANCE LOG REQUIRED AT MASS: Ottawa Public Health requires all places of worship to maintain an attendance log for purposes of contact tracing in case of an outbreak. You will notice a sign-in sheet when you attend: when you enter, please sanitize your hands and then print your name and phone number on the sheet. We will prepare pre-printed lists when possible so that those who regularly attend will only need to place a checkmark beside their name. Please be assured these records will be kept private and stored safely - they will only be disclosed to a medical officer of health or an inspector under the Health Protection and Promotion Act on request. Information will be destroyed after 30 days. Many thanks for your continued co-operation!

Our Lady of Fatima Parish, dedicated to the Mother of God, seeks to fulfill the call of Jesus to “come follow me,” to be true worshippers of the Father through the power of the Holy spirit, and to love one another as Christ has loved us.

1) Reflection on the 21st Sunday

in Ordinary Time: Authority is earned, not imposed. Human authority, including the church, is accountable and derived from God and answerable to others. This is the foundation of the Church's subject to Christ.



2) Reflection on the 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time: Following Christ in discipleship entails taking up the cross and accepting suffering as inevitable and embracing it when called for!

3) The Province has made it mandatory to wear a mask/face covering so as to reduce transmission of COVID19. The policy is to ensure that we shall not have a second wave which could set us back. We have also entered stage 3 where most businesses have cautiously re-opened, but with social-distancing. We are grateful for volunteers who exercise their discipleship during this critical time to assist us so that we can ensure the safety and security of our parishioners. Please check your body temperature before leaving home. Please wear a personal mask/face cover to protect yourselves and others and make use of the hand sanitizers.

4) During the pandemic the provincial regulation and diocesan guidelines are that we should suspend communion in the tongue until the pandemic is over and it is safe to do so. Please be respectful of the concern for safety during this time!

5) For the month of August at least, we shall not have servers, nor choir/music during Mass. We hope to resume having an organist/cantor in September after the Labour Day weekend (Sept. 12-13) provided there is no second wave of infection.

6) We will keep the regular weekend Mass schedule in order to ensure not too many will be turned away. We shall help you fill your containers with holy water, and vigil lights can be lit before Masses only. Offerings for vigil lights can be placed in the tube near the statue of Our Lady of Fatima.

7) Please do not linger in church after Mass, as we need time to sanitize the church. Entrance will be at the main door and exit will be near the ramp door by St. Joseph's statue.

8) We continue to live-stream at the 4:30pm Saturday and 10:00am Mass on Sundays whenever possible. Those who are not ready to return to church for Mass can benefit from it if you have a computer, cell phone or other electronic devices. Please connect via the parish website at www.fatimaparish.ca!

9) During the month of August the bulletins will be available every two weeks. If necessary, we shall send you an e-mail message to update you on evolving situations.

10) We are thankful that weekend worship is possible, but things are not yet back to normal. At this time we shall keep the regular confession and Mass schedule (Monday-Friday morning Masses only). Anything beyond will have to wait until we have some normalcy.

11) The province now requires contact-tracing for worshippers in the event someone is found to be a carrier of the virus. Please co-operate with us so that we can respond to this safety measure which is also sanctioned by the Archdiocese.

Welcome back! We know these are a lot of changes to process. Don't worry – we will have volunteers to guide you along the way. We have missed you and are looking forward to being able to worship together in person or watch the Mass which will be live streamed at 4:30pm on Saturday and at 10:00am on Sunday whenever possible.
