1) Passion (Palm) Sunday Reflection: Today's gospel is an account of the Passion of the Lord. The Passion



signals the arrival of Holy Week and ushers in the last few days of our Lenten journey. Lent comes to a close when the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper begins. The time of preparation is almost over; the Easter Triduum is close at hand. As God's beloved people, let us use these last days well. And then, when they are over, let us celebrate the feastB from beginning to endB with all the spirit and power and joy that we possess. Let's make this year's feast the greatest spiritual event of our lives. [National Bulletin of Liturgy, vol. 33 #165]

- 2) The ongoing widespread of coronavirus in the city necessitates the churches to be completely shut and locked down. We shall keep you updated through our weekly post on the website. In the meantime, I urge you to be patient, keep a safe distance of at least two meters so as to prevent the strain on our health care, as well as ensure your own well-being. We hope everyone can cooperate so that we can quickly restore our regular worship and interaction.
- 3) As a result of the lock down the Parish Office is closed. Irene and June are working at home and messages are checked daily.
- 4) Last Sunday's donation was for Development & Peace, I trust that in due course we will submit the amount for the needs of the developing world. We also have a regular donation on Good Friday for the needs of the Holy Land. This too will be delayed to a later time.
- 5) In preparation for Holy Week, the Triduum and Easter, the bishop gave us information with regard to the celebration of Reconciliation, Devotions and scripture readings. These are posted in the Update to Parishioners dated March 26, 2020 (see our website).
- 6) The Holy Week service will not involve participation of parishioners, as both the Vatican and our diocese have issued guidelines for Triduum celebrations in the absence of the Congregation. I hope to quickly master the skill of having live-streamed Mass available for your participation online! Stay tuned for details.
- 7) I shall do the blessing of palms this Sunday, hopefully I shall soon be able to distribute to you at a later date.
- 8) The Rite of Baptism, Confirmation and First Communion for our Elect Naga Lakshmi will be deferred to Pentecost Sunday. We hope by then there will be full participation of the faithful to welcome her as a disciple of Christ!
- 9) Prayers for vocation for Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion: For all those being called to share in the passion of Christ as priests, deacons and in the consecrated life, that they will echo His Eternal Words of love and mercy in their own faithfulness to the Father's will, we pray to the Lord.
